Chapter 6 Public Boat Ways Regulations

- 601** For the purpose of this Ordinance, the following Public Boat Ways Regulations shall be observed.
- 601.1** Vehicle parking upon or at the approaches to the public boat ways is prohibited.
- 601.2** No watercraft may be placed and left upon the boat ways for more than forty-eight (48) consecutive hours without first obtaining special permission from the municipal officers.
- 601.3** As a means of defraying costs for the administration of this Ordinance and the maintenance of the ways, service fees for the use of the ways shall be charged for the following services. Such fees shall be set by the municipal officers from time-to-time, after notice and hearing and shall be attached as an appendix to this Ordinance. **(BOS 06/06/95)**
- a. Winter Storage
 - b. Ways Use Fees
 - c. Winch Fees
- 601.4** In those instances when a coastal storm threatens the municipality and therefore public activities upon or around the public boat ways might result in personal injury or loss of life, the Harbormaster shall have full authority to secure the ways and prohibit any public access or trespass until the storm subsides and the Harbormaster deems the ways safe for public use. Exceptions to these restrictions may include emergency and public service personnel.
