

INTRODUCTION

Ogunquit is a dynamic, changing community, and its year-round population continues to grow. Its fame as a tourist destination continues to spread, while the length of the tourist season continues to increase. As a result, new issues and challenges face the community.

Ogunquit developed and adopted a comprehensive plan in the late 1980s and revised it in the early 1990s. That plan served the community well and many of the proposals in it have been implemented. However, now it is time to re-evaluate the future direction of the community and what the Town needs to do to address those new issues and challenges.
