

The Town of Ogunquit, “*Beautiful Place by the Sea*”, has made it a priority to increase recycling in our town. The recycling rules and regulations are for residents, guests, and commercial businesses. Suggestions for improvements to our system are always welcome

**Why recycle?** Recycling saves tax dollars. **Each ton** removed from the waste stream **will save almost \$400 in tax dollars**. It also makes sense to recycle and reuse materials rather than to simply throw them into a landfill.

**Who should recycle?** Everyone should be recycling. Whether you are year-round or seasonal, resident or business, we all must do our part in keeping Ogunquit, the beautiful place by the sea, attractive.

**What can be recycled? Corrugated Cardboard and Paper Products**, including newspapers, magazines, phone books, catalogs, junk mail and paper bags. **Paperboard**, including clean food boxes (with liners and metal removed) such as a cereal boxes, shoe and shirt boxes, tubes from toilet paper and paper towel rolls, writing pad blocks and poster board. **Glass, cans, plastic containers and aluminum**, including food cans, beverage cans, aerosol cans, glass bottles and jars, and window glass.

**Items that CANNOT be recycled** include sanitary tissues, used paper towels, waxed milk cartons and juice boxes, propane tanks, mercury switches or devices. If there is any doubt as to whether an item can be recycled, please check first. Entire truck loads of recycled material can be rejected and land filled if undesired items are mixed in.

**PLEASE NOTE** that all items to be recycled must be clean and free of contaminants. If you have any questions on whether or not an item can be recycled, or need to know the proper way to dispose of an item please call the **Transfer Station at 646-0478**.



## TRANSFER STATION RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Trash will be accepted **ONLY** if it is generated from within the boundaries of the Town of Ogunquit.
- Individual users of the Transfer Station must have a disposal permit affixed to the right front passenger window of their vehicle. Permits can be obtained at the Ogunquit Police Department.
- All trash must be contained in plastic bags or trash barrels.
- Fees for disposal are per the posted Schedule paid to the attendant prior to disposal.
- Debris from building construction or demolition will require a **temporary** disposal permit, which can be obtained from the Town Office; fees for disposal per the posted Schedule.
- The Attendants word is final.

## HOW TO RECYCLE

### Corrugated Cardboard, Paperboard (boxes) and Paper Products:

Keep clean and dry and fold flat  
Remove product samples and plastic cards from mail  
Discard all foil and plastic liners  
Discard metal spouts, cutting strips  
Recycle loose or in brown paper bags

### Glass, Cans, Plastic Containers and Aluminum:

Labels and nozzles left on are okay (*No plastic bags*)

### Do not include with recyclables:

Styrofoam, light bulbs, photo film, rubber items, waxed paper or cartons, packing peanuts, juice boxes

## SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL FEE SCHEDULE

### Recycling is encouraged! Recycled waste is free!

Bagged Household Waste (Residential)  
One free 33 gallon trash bag or barrel per day

- **Each additional** 33 gallon bag or barrel - **\$1/bag**
- Non-permitted Rentals - **\$2/bag**
- Un-compacted Loose Waste - **\$.10/lb.**
- Trash Cans and Trash Bags **\$2/each**  
Larger than 33 Gallons

**Any amounts up to and over 33 gallons = minimum charge of \$1.00**

All business loads or large residential load of household waste will be weighed.

### Construction & Demolition

Bag (33 gallon) or Barrel	\$3.00 each
By weight (large loads)	\$.10/lb
Asphalt Shingles	\$.10/lb
Wood (by 33 gallon bag)	\$2.00 each
Lumber, Clean Wood	\$.05/lb

### Furniture & Bulky Items

Sinks	\$3.00 each
Toilet	\$10.00 each
Tubs, Showers	\$10.00 each
Mattresses, Box Springs	\$10.00 each
Rugs (by size - sq. ft.)	\$.10/sq. ft.
Carpet (weighed)	\$.10/lb
Lg. Chairs/Sofas	\$10.00 each
Sm. Wood Furniture	\$2.00 each
Lg. Wood Furniture	\$5.00 each
Mixed large loads by weight	\$.08/lb

### Construction/Renovation Waste

When alterations cause limits to be exceeded, a roll-off container needs to be utilized. Arrangements and fees are the user's responsibility. Information may be obtained from the Code Enforcement Officer.

No commercial compacted waste will be accepted without permission from the Town Office.

It currently costs the town (*YOU*):

**\$62.50/ton** tipping fee  
(Household Waste)  
➤ (average 10 ton/box)

**\$198.50/ton** hauling fee per box

In contrast: we pay only the hauling fee for bottles/cans (\$198.50) and we are PAID for our cardboard and paper!
