To William P. Hancock, a Police Officer, in the Ogunquit Village Corporation in the Town of Wells, County of York and State of Maine:

GREETINGS:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Ogunquit Village Corporation, qualified by law to vote in Corporation affairs, to meet in the Dunaway Community Center in said Corporation on Thursday, the eighth day of May, 1975 at seven-thirty o'clock in the evening, then and there to act on the following articles:

- ARTICLE 1. To choose a Moderator to preside at said meeting.
- ARTICLE 2. To see if the Corporation will vote to carry forward the amounts in the following accounts: Regional Planning Commission - \$590.00, Insurance - \$784.40, Winter Roads - \$3,462.26, Marginal Way -\$1,312.79, Equipment - \$9,340.61, Beach Parking -\$23,153.20, Building Permits - \$5.00, Social Security-\$2,281.52, Federal Withholding Tax - \$746.90, State of Maine Withholding Tax - \$222.10 and Maine Blue Cross and Blue Shield - \$34.66.
- ARTICLE 3. To see if the Corporation will vote to appropriate the sum of \$1,500.00 for the Corporation Retirement System.
- Budget Committee recommends: Yes.
- ARTICLE 4. To see if the Corporation will vote to appropriate the sum of \$2,640.00 for the Planning Board for the ensuing year.
- Budget Committee recommends: Yes.
- ARTICLE 5. To see if the Corporation will vote to appropriate an additional amount not to exceed \$3,500.00 for the salaries of the Town Managers.
- ARTICLE 6. To see if the Corporation will vote to appropriate an additional amount of \$1,000.00 for the Contingent Account (office account including auditor, manager expenses, clerk hire and office expenses).
- ARTICLE 7. To see if the Corporation will vote to appropriate an additional sum of \$3,000.00 for the running expenses of the Dunaway Community Center.
- ARTICLE 8. To see if the Corporation will vote to collect parking fees on a seven days per week basis from the Lower Parking Lot on River Road, with fees of \$1.00 on weekdays and \$2.00 on holidays and weekends.
