

WARRANT FOR SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
of the
TOWN OF OGUNQUIT, MAINE
May 12, 1982

To: WILLIAM P. HANCOCK, JR., CHIEF OF POLICE OF THE TOWN OF OGUNQUIT,
COUNTY OF YORK AND STATE OF MAINE:

GREETINGS:

In the Name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Town of Ogunquit, qualified by law to vote in municipal affairs to meet in the Dunaway Community Center in said town on Wednesday, the twelfth day of May, 1982, A.D., at seven-thirty o'clock in the evening then and there to act on the following Articles:

ARTICLE 1: To elect a Moderator to preside at said Meeting.

ARTICLE 2: To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to expend an amount not to exceed Seventeen Thousand Dollars (\$17,000) for necessary repairs and engineering costs for the Perkins Cove drawbridge; further, to authorize the Board of Selectmen to waive formal bid procedures to expedite repairs to the bridge.

NOTE: The bridge malfunctioned in early April 1982. The Board of Selectmen has retained legal and engineering counsel concerning possible recover of repair funds from the constructing contractor. It is the intention of this article to repair the bridge to an operable state by May 31, 1982.

ARTICLE 3: To see if the Town will vote to allocate an additional Five Thousand Dollars (\$5000) from excess excise tax receipts to the Highway Department for snow removal costs.

NOTE: The March 6, 1982 Annual Town Meeting appropriated \$55,000 in excise tax receipts against the general Highway budget; as of May 1, 1982, \$30,000 of those anticipated revenues have been collected. This article would allocate the first \$5,000 in receipts over the \$55,000 for snow removal costs necessary before the end of the fiscal year (December 31, 1982). The annual appropriation of \$14,500 was expended during the period of January 1, 1982 to date (balance of \$312.)
