WARRANT for SPECIAL MEETING

of the

OGUNQUIT VILLAGE CORPORATION

To WILLIAM H. HOLMAN, a Police Officer in the Ogunquit Village Corporation in the Town of Wells, County of York and State of Maine:

GREETINGS:

In the name of the State of Maine you are hereby required to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Ogunquit Village Corporation, qualified by law to vote in Corporation affairs, to meet in Firemen's Hall in said Corporation on Thursday, the twenty-fourth day of May, 1973 A. D. at seven-thirty o'clock in the evening then and there to act on the following Articles:

ARTICLE 1: To choose a Moderator to preside at said Meeting.

ARTICLE 2: to see if the Corporation will vote to rescind its action whereby it voted under Article 41 at the 1973 Annual Corporation Meeting with respect to Beach Parking, as follows:

"that no motel or hotel or rooming houses shall have seasonal passes; residents, taxpayers and renters, seasonal or year 'round, may purchase seasonal passes at \$5.00. Daily rates \$2.50 weekends and \$1.00 daily."

and to continue the fees on the same basis as in 1972. On petition of Kenneth R. Young, Sr. and forty-five other.

The purpose of this Article is to vote again on the re-cission because at the Special Meeting held on May 9, 1973 the legality of the vote taken was questioned and the Board of Overseers were advised to resubmit the Article to another Special Meeting.
