

SPECIAL MEETING

WARRANT FOR SPECIAL MEETING MAY 25, 1966

To Cecil F. Perkins, a Police Officer in the Ogunquit Village Corporation in the Town of Wells, County of York and State of Maine: Greetings:

In the Name of the State of Maine you are hereby required to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Ogunquit Village Corporation, qualified by law to Vote in Corporation affairs, to meet in Fireman's Hall in said Corporation on Wednesday, the Twenty-Fifth day of May 1966, A.D. at seven-thirty o'clock in the evening, then and there to act on the following articles:

Art. 1: To choose a moderator to preside at said meeting.

Art. 2: To see if the Corporation will vote to appropriate the sum of \$3,155.95 to be added to the \$9,800.00 they appropriated at the annual meeting for a Front End Loader, \$2,044.77 from money unappropriated at the annual meeting April 4, 1966 and \$1,111.18 from unappropriated surplus, so as to purchase a larger and more practical machine with 7/8 yd. bucket, 24" bucket on the backhoe with digging depth of 15 ft., sweeper and cab.

Art. 3: To hear a report of the Overseers on Article #44 of the Annual Meeting on Bath House at the Beach.

Art. 4: To transact such other business as may legally come before this meeting.
