

WARRANT FOR SPECIAL MEETING

OF THE

OGUNQUIT VILLAGE CORPORATION

JUNE 2, 1980

To WILLIAM P. HANCOCK, JR., Chief of Police in the Ogunquit Village Corporation, in the Town of Wells, County of York and State of Maine:

GREETINGS:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Ogunquit Village Corporation, qualified by law to vote in Corporation affairs, to meet in the S. Judson Dunaway Community Center, in said Corporation on Monday, the second day of June, 1980, A.D., at seven-thirty o'clock in the evening then and there to act on the following Articles:

ARTICLE 1 - To elect a moderator to preside at said meeting.

ARTICLE 2 - To see if the Corporation will vote to adopt a proposed ordinance dated May 23, 1980, to change the name of the Ogunquit Village Corporation to the Town of Ogunquit, as approved by the Board of Overseers.

ARTICLE 3 - To see if the Corporation will vote to adopt a proposed ordinance dated May 23, 1980, to change the name of the Board of Overseers to the Board of Selectmen, as approved by the Board of Overseers.

ARTICLE 4 - To see if the Corporation will vote to approve a proposed Administrative Code, dated May 23, 1980, as approved by the Board of Overseers.

ARTICLE 5 - To see if the Corporation will vote to adopt a proposed Public Assistance Ordinance, dated May 23, 1980, concerning guidelines for distributing public assistance, as approved by the Board of Overseers.

ARTICLE 6 - To see if the Corporation will vote to adopt a proposed Noise Ordinance, dated May 23, 1980, concerning generation of noise so as to disturb the peace, as approved by the Board of Overseers.

ARTICLE 7 - To see if the Corporation will vote to adopt a proposed Solid Waste Ordinance, dated May 23, 1980, concerning solid waste disposal and the Ogunquit Transfer Station, as approved by the Board of Overseers.

ARTICLE 8 - To see if the Corporation will vote to adopt which of the following proposed Animal Control Ordinances pertaining to the Ogunquit Beach:

- a. To ban dogs from the Ogunquit Beach Area at all times;
- b. To ban dogs from the Ogunquit Beach Area from May 15th to October 1st.

A no vote on both of these proposed Ordinances would mean that dogs are permitted in the Ogunquit Beach Area at all times. These proposed Ordinances, dated May 23, 1980, have been approved by the Board of Overseers.

ARTICLE 9 - To see if the Corporation will vote to adopt which of the following proposed Animal Control Ordinances pertaining to the Marginal Way:

- a. To ban dogs from the Marginal Way at all times;
- b. To ban dogs from the Marginal Way from May 15th to October 1st.

A no vote on both of these proposed Ordinances would mean that dogs are permitted on the Marginal Way at all times. These proposed Ordinances, dated May 23, 1980, have been approved by the Board of Overseers.

Warrant for Special Meeting of the Ogunquit Village Corporation - June 2, 1980

ARTICLE 10 - To see if the Corporation will vote to adopt which of the following proposed Animal Control Ordinances, pertaining to a leash requirement, when an animal or pet is off the premises of the owner:

- a. To require a leash at all times;
- b. To require a leash from May 15th to October 1st.

The Maine State Statute requiring a leash or personal control of the owner (voice command) would apply from October 1st to May 15th if the proposed Ordinance (b) was adopted and at all times if both proposed Ordinances were denied. These proposed Ordinances, dated May 23, 1980, have been approved by the Board of Overseers.

ARTICLE 11 - To see if the Corporation will vote to adopt a proposed Public Resources and Conservation Ordinance, dated May 23, 1980, concerning public use and conduct on parks, and all other public areas, as approved by the Board of Overseers.

ARTICLE 12 - To see if the Corporation will vote to adopt the proposed Animal Control Ordinance of Ogunquit, dated May 23, 1980, concerning animal control and dog licensing, as approved by the Board of Overseers.

ARTICLE 13 - To see if the Corporation will vote to adopt the proposed Alcohol Licensing Review Ordinance, dated May 23, 1980, concerning procedures in reviewing liquor license renewals, as approved by the Board of Overseers.

ARTICLE 14 - To see if the Corporation will vote to adopt the proposed Special Amusement Ordinance of the Town of Ogunquit, dated May 23, 1980, concerning issuance of amusement licenses to liquor licenses and conditions of operations, as approved by the Board of Overseers.

ARTICLE 15 - To see if the Corporation will vote to adopt the proposed Ordinance Prohibiting Obscenity for Commercial Gain, dated May 23, 1980, concerning prohibition of obscene exhibition for profit, as approved by the Board of Overseers.

ARTICLE 16 - To see if the Corporation will vote to adopt the proposed Transient Business Ordinance, dated May 23, 1980, concerning the licensing and regulation of transient businesses in Ogunquit, as approved by the Board of Overseers.

ARTICLE 17 - To see if the Corporation will vote to adopt the proposed Yard and Garage Sale Ordinance, dated May 23, 1980, concerning the regulation of yard or garage sales, as approved by the Board of Overseers.

ARTICLE 18 - To see if the Corporation will vote to adopt the proposed Bottle Club Ordinance, dated May 23, 1980, concerning the regulation of bottle club hours in operation, as approved by the Board of Overseers.
