

**SPECIAL TOWN MEETING WARRANT
TOWN OF OGUNQUIT**

Tuesday, June 10, 2003

TO: FREDERICK M. RUBINO, Chief of Police of the Town of Ogunquit, in the County of York, State of Maine:

GREETINGS: In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Ogunquit in said county and state, qualified by law to vote in town affairs, to meet at the Dunaway Community Center in said Town on Tuesday, the tenth (10th) day of June, 2003 A.D. at nine o'clock in the morning (9:00 a.m.) until eight o'clock in the evening (8:00 p.m.) to act upon the following articles by secret ballot, to wit:

ARTICLE 1: To elect a Moderator to preside at said Meeting.


ARTICLE 2: To elect a Selectman to fill a vacancy for an unexpired term ending at the conclusion of the 2005 Annual Town Meeting.


ARTICLE 3: Shall the Town vote to repeal the 1993 Comprehensive Plan as previously accepted, adopted and amended through November 3, 1993; and furthermore vote to accept and adopt the 2003 Update of the Ogunquit Comprehensive Plan whereupon said plan was developed in accordance with the provisions of Title 30-A, Chapter 187 of the Maine Revised Statutes Annotated and made available for public inspection in the municipal offices?

ARTICLE 4: Shall the Town vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to enter into ninety-nine (99) year lease agreements with the Ogunquit Fire Company to allow the continued use of Town property and buildings in the vicinity of the Fire Station, under such terms and conditions as the Selectmen may deem to be in the best interests of the Town?


