

WARRANT FOR A SPECIAL TOWN MEETING  
OF THE  
TOWN OF OGUNQUIT

TO: Michael W. Pardue, Chief of Police in the Town of Ogunquit,  
County of York and State of Maine.

**GREETINGS:**

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby requested to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Town of Ogunquit, qualified by law to vote in Town affairs, to meet in the Dunaway Community Center, in said Town on Tuesday, the sixteenth day of June, 1998, A.D. at seven o'clock in the evening to vote on Articles 1 through 4.

**ARTICLE 1:** To elect a Moderator to preside over said Meeting.

**ARTICLE 2:** Shall the Town appropriate a sum not to exceed Six Hundred and Twenty-Two Thousand, Five Hundred and Sixty-Five Dollars (\$622,565) to fund the costs of public improvements and equipment approved by the voters under Articles 36 through 45 inclusive of the April, 1998 Annual Town Meeting, and to fund said appropriation, authorize the Treasurer and Chairman of the Board of Selectmen to issue general obligation securities of the Town of Ogunquit (including temporary notes in anticipation of the sale thereof) in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$622,565 and the discretion to fix the date(s), maturity(ies), interest rate(s), call(s) for redemption, place(s) of payment, form, and other details of said securities, including execution and delivery of said securities on behalf of the Town of Ogunquit, and to provide for the sale thereof, is hereby delegated to the Treasurer and Chairman of the Board of Selectmen.

**EXPLANATION AND RECOMMENDATION:**

The purpose of this Article is to confirm and ratify the method of funding the costs of public improvements and equipment purchases previously approved by the voters at the April 6, 1998 Annual Town Meeting. The Board of Selectmen recommends approval of this Article.

**FINANCIAL STATEMENT**


At an estimated maximum interest rate of 4.60% the estimated costs of this bond issue will be:

3. Validity:

The validity of the bonds and of the voters' ratification of bonds may not be affected by any errors in the above estimates. If the actual amount of the total debt service for the bond issue varies from the estimate, the ratification by the electors is nevertheless conclusive and the validity of the bond issue is not affected by reason of the variance.


**ARTICLE 3:** Shall an Ordinance entitled "Shellfish Management" be enacted? A copy of the proposed Ordinance is attached and made a part of this Warrant as Exhibit A and has been made available in the Office of the Town Clerk for inspection, use, and examination by the public.

NOTE: Adoption of a Shellfish Management Ordinance is mandated every three (3) years pursuant to MRSA 12, Sections 6671 and 6681.

**ARTICLE 4:** Shall the Town vote to approve the addition of a new Chapter 7 to Title II of the Ogunquit Municipal Code which Chapter to be entitled the "Civil Emergency Preparedness" Ordinance. A copy of the proposed Ordinance is attached and made a part of this Warrant as Exhibit B and has been made available in the Office of the Town Clerk for inspection, use and examination by the public.






