

WARRANT FOR SPECIAL REFERENDUM

OF THE

TOWN OF OGUNQUIT

JUNE 30, 1981

To WILLIAM P. HANCOCK, JR., Chief of Police of the Town of Ogunquit, County of York and State of Maine:

GREETINGS:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Ogunquit, qualified by law to vote in municipal affairs to meet in the Judson Dunaway Community Center in said town on Tuesday, the thirtieth day of June, 1981 A.D., at ten o'clock in the morning until eight o'clock in the evening, then and there to act on Articles 1 and 2:

ARTICLE 1: To elect a Moderator to preside at said Meeting.

ARTICLE 2: To vote by secret ballot on the following referendum question:

"Shall the following vote be adopted?"

- (a) To authorize the municipal officers of the Town of Ogunquit, Maine, to purchase certain property of the Estate of Mary Kennedy located on Obed's Lane in the Town of Ogunquit; and
- (b) That a sum not to exceed Two Hundred Ninety-Nine Thousand Dollars, \$299,000.00, is hereby appropriated for the purpose of providing funds for the acquisition of said property of the Estate of Mary Kennedy, and to meet and fund said appropriation, the Treasurer and the Board of Selectmen are authorized to issue general obligation securities of the Town of Ogunquit, Maine in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$299,000.00; and
- (c) That a sum not to exceed Two Thousand Seven Hundred and Fifty Dollars, \$2,750.00, is hereby appropriated for the purpose of providing funds for surveying, title search, legal and other related costs in connection with the acquisition of said property of the Estate of Mary Kennedy and to meet and fund said appropriation, the Treasurer and the Board of Selectmen are authorized to issue general obligation securities of the Town of Ogunquit, Maine, in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$2,750.00; and
- (d) That the discretion to fix the date, maturity(ies), denomination(s), interest rate(s), places(s) of payment, form and other details of said securities, and to provide for the sale thereof including the execution and delivery of said securities against payment therefor, is hereby delegated to the Treasurer and the Board of Selectmen".

The Board of Selectmen hereby gives notice that the polls shall be open for voting purposes at ten o'clock in the morning or as soon as possible thereafter of the day of said election and that the polls will not be closed earlier than eight o'clock in the evening of said day.


