

WARRANT FOR FIRST TOWN MEETING ELECTION
OGUNQUIT, MAINE
July 1, 1980

TO: JEAN S. KIMBALL, A NOTARY PUBLIC IN THE COUNTY OF YORK AND STATE OF MAINE:

GREETINGS:


In the Name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Ogunquit Village Corporation, qualified by law to vote in Corporation affairs, that the voters of the Town of Ogunquit will meet in the Judson Dunaway Community Center in said Corporation and Town on Tuesday, the first day of July, 1980, A.D., at eight o'clock in the morning until six o'clock in the evening, then and there to act on Articles 1 and 2:

ARTICLE 1: To elect a Moderator to preside at said Meeting Election.

ARTICLE 2: To elect a five (5) member Board of Selectmen; the two (2) highest vote recipients to serve terms ending at the Annual Town Meeting in 1982 and the next three (3) highest vote recipients to serve terms ending at the Annual Town Meeting in 1981.

The Board of Overseers hereby gives notice that the polls shall be open for voting purposes at eight o'clock in the morning or as soon as possible thereafter of the day of said Meeting Election and that the polls will not be closed earlier than six o'clock in the evening of said day. 
