To CECIL PERKINS, a Police Officer in the OGUNQUIT VILLAGE CORPORATION IN the TOWN of WELLS, COUNTY of YORK and STATE of MAINE: GREETINGS:

In the name of the State of Maine you are hereby required to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the OGUNQUIT VILLAGE CORPORATION qualified by law to vote in CORPORATION affairs to meet in FIREMEN'S HALL in said CORPORATION on MONDAY, the eleventh day of JULY 1966 A.D. at seven thirty o'clock in the evening then and there to act on the following articles:

ARTICLE 1: To choose a Moderator to preside at said meeting.

ARTICLE 2: To see if the Village will vote to spray for Mosquito control by airplane, this season on petition of EDMOND C. McLAUGHLIN AND THIRTY FOUR OTHERS, AND if so what sum of money will they appropriate for same from the UNAPPROPRIATED SURPLUS ACCOUNT.

ARTICLE 3: To see if the CORPORATION will vote to accept the deed from the heirs of the CHARLES C. HOYT EST. to the right-of-way 5.67 feet wide between the BUYSE property and the BURDON property on the EAST SIDE OF SHORE ROAD.
