

**SPECIAL TOWN MEETING WARRANT**  
**TOWN OF OGUNQUIT**  
Monday, December 30, 2002

TO: FREDERICK M. RUBINO, Chief of Police of the Town of Ogunquit, in the County of York, State of Maine:

GREETING: In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Ogunquit in said county and state, qualified by law to vote in town affairs, to meet at the Dunaway Community Center in said Town on Monday, the thirtieth (30<sup>th</sup>) day of December, 2002 A.D. at seven o'clock in the evening (7:00 p.m.) to act upon the following articles, to wit:


**ARTICLE 1:** To elect a Moderator to preside at said Meeting.

**ARTICLE 2:** Shall the Town vote to transfer the sum of three thousand one hundred eleven dollars (\$3,111.00) from the Tax Anticipation Note Interest Account into the Insurance Operating Budget pursuant to the provisions of Section 504 of the Town Charter in order to cover over-expenditures incurred during the current fiscal year?

**ARTICLE 3:** Shall the Town vote to transfer the sum of forty-two thousand seven hundred sixteen dollars (\$42,716.00) from the Communications Operating Budget into the Police Department Operating Budget pursuant to the provisions of Section 504 of the Town Charter in order to cover over-expenditures incurred during the current fiscal year?

**ARTICLE 4:** Shall the Town vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen on behalf of the Town to join with other participating municipal and quasi-municipal employers in a multiple employer welfare arrangement for the provisions of health and related benefits as authorized by Title 24-A M.R.S.A. §6601; said arrangement to be known as the Maine Municipal Employees Health Trust; and for that purpose and in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements among participating employers, to authorize the Board of Selectmen to enter into a participating agreement on behalf of the Town and take whatever other actions may be necessary. The authority granted herein shall continue until revoked.
