

WARRANT RETURN FOR THE ANNUAL TOWN MEETING  
OF THE  
TOWN OF OGUNQUIT

April 5 & 7, 1997

The Annual Town Meeting was called to order by Town Clerk Judy Shaw-Kagiliery with the Reading of the Call, Return and First Article. The Meeting convened at 9:00 A.M.

Ann Clark, Marjorie Esau, Norma Turnbull, Christine Murphy and Judith Yates served as Ballot Clerks/Counters. Articles 1-2 were done by secret ballot. A total of 259 people voted at the April 5 Town Meeting. Polls closed at 6:00 P.M.

ARTICLE 1: Mary Littlefield was elected Moderator and sworn in by Town Clerk Judy Shaw-Kagiliery.

Continuation of the April 5, 1997 Annual Town Meeting proceeded at 7:09 P.M. on Monday, April 7, 1997. Wayne Adams was nominated and elected as Deputy Moderator to serve in the absence of Mary Littlefield. Mr. Adams was sworn in by Town Clerk Judy Shaw-Kagiliery. A total of 151 citizens attended the Meeting. Moderator Adams called for a Motion to extend the courtesy to non-residents to speak during the Meeting. The Motion was made and seconded to do so. Motion passed, as presented, by a show of hands.

Prior to the vote, discussion ensued with the pros and cons of the issue regarding the inequities of the present school funding formula involving the Wells/Ogunquit CSD. Superintendent Thomas Forcella and CSD Trustee Ann Page spoke against the question and Board Chairman John Miller and former CSD Trustee Stillman Bradish spoke for the question. Following discussion, Moderator Adams called for a vote which was 136 for and 5 opposed.

Selectmen Smith voiced his opposition to the question as it had been presented and felt additional concerns should be addressed before coming to the people for a vote. Following the discussion, Moderator Adams call for a vote. Motion was defeated.
- ARTICLE 7: Chairman Miller moved to approve the Article as proposed only to open discussion. Motion seconded. Discussion ensued with Selectmen giving the definition of Type I restaurants (inside wait staff) vs Type II restaurants (outside wait staff). Matthew Sakey of Joan's Restaurant stated he was the author of the petitioned article and was looking to have the town allow outdoor dining on his front deck. Bruce Bernard of Bernard's Bakery who also utilizes the same deck also spoke in favor of the question. Planning Board member, Charles Dahill spoke against the question feeling it should be brought back to the Planning Board for further review and discussion. Joan Sakey of Joan's Restaurant felt the Planning Board had not addressed the issue when it first was presented to them and were being very unfair to the petitioners. Following discussion, Moderator Adams called for a vote. Motion was defeated.


