

**WARRANT RETURN FOR THE SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
OF THE
TOWN OF OGUNQUIT
Tuesday, June 10, 2008**

The Special Town Meeting was called to order by Town Clerk Judy Shaw-Kagiliery with the Reading of the Call, Return and First Article. The polls were declared open at 9:00AM.

Marjorie Esau, Blanche Feinberg, Frederica Hart, Alan Kupper, Leila Kupper, and Mary Littlefield served as Ballot Clerks/Counters. A total of 277 people voted at the polls. Moderator Murphy closed the polls at 8:00PM and the counting of ballots commenced.

Article 1: To elect a Moderator to preside at said Meeting. [NOTE: This question is not intended to be acted upon as part of the official secret ballot at the Special Town Meeting].

Article 2: To elect a Wells-Ogunquit Community School District Trustee for a three (3) year term to commence on July 1, 2008; term ending June 30, 2011.
