WARRANT RETURN FOR A SPECIAL TOWN MEETING  
OF THE  
TOWN OF OGUNQUIT

The Special Town Meeting was held on Tuesday, August 13, 1996, A.D. and called to order by Town Clerk Judy Shaw-Kagiliery with the Reading of the Call, Return, and First Article.

The Meeting convened at 7:10 P.M. with twenty (20) registered voters in attendance. Norman Turnbull served as Ballot Clerk.

**ARTICLE 1:** David Ott was elected Moderator and sworn in by Town Clerk Judy Shaw-Kagiliery. Mr. Ott began by advising the legislative body he would be conducting the Meeting pursuant to the Maine Moderator's procedures.

**ARTICLE 2:** Motion was made and seconded to accept the Article, as read. Roy Wooldridge asked for a brief explanation of the *Odyssey of the Mind* was. Passed by a show of hands.

**ARTICLE 3:** Motion was made and seconded to accept the Article, as read. Passed by a show of hands.

**ARTICLE 4:** Motion was made and seconded to accept the Article, as read. Passed by a show of hands.

**ARTICLE 5:** Motion was made and seconded to accept the Article, as read. Passed by a show of hands.

**ARTICLE 6:** Motion was made and seconded to accept the Article, as read. Raymond Hazen and Corey Staples raised some issues in regard to the wording of the proposed changes to the Ordinance relative to needing approval by the Harbormaster prior to going on the Waiting List when upgrading the size of a vessel. Chairman Miller stated the intent was to deal with vessels going from a small boat mooring to a larger boat mooring not ones upgrading to a larger size vessel that did not affect the mooring. Mr. Ott advised the legislative body that he would have to move against an amendment to the Article. Chairman Miller stated they could go ahead and vote on the Article, as read, and then later have another public hearing on this particular issue and go before the people, if they desire further changes or clarification.

Mr. Ott then called for a vote on the original Motion. Passed, as read, by a show of hands.

**ARTICLE 7:** Motion was made and seconded to accept the Article, as read. Ted Snyder inquired as to whether this involved raising additional monies. Chairman Miller responded in the affirmative. Roy Wooldridge asked how we could take this out of taxation when the tax rate had already been set. Chairman Miller advised the tax rate had not yet been set as they had to wait for the school budget. Mr. Ott then called for a vote - Passed by a show of hands.

**ARTICLE 8:** Motion was made and seconded to accept the Article, as read. Mr. Ott read the first part of the Article and then asked if it was the wish of the legislative body to forego the reading of the remainder of the Article and thereby accept so much that was read as constituting reading it as a whole. This was deemed in the

affirmative. Mr. Ott asked if there was to be further discussion. As there was none, he then called for a vote. The Article passed by a show of hands.

Following a Motion and second, Mr. Ott declared the Meeting adjourned at 7:30 P.M.
