

WARRANT RETURN FOR A SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
OF THE
TOWN OF OGUNQUIT

TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 28, 2000

The Special Town Meeting was held on Tuesday, November 28, 2000, A.D. and called to order at 7:05 PM by Town Clerk Judy Shaw-Kagiliery with the Reading of the Call, Return, and First Article. A total of 46 voters attended the meeting.

Mary Littlefield served as Ballot Clerk.

ARTICLE 1: Bradley Moulton was elected Moderator and sworn in by Town Clerk Judy S. Kagiliery.


ARTICLE 2: Motion was made and seconded to accept the Article as read. Prior to the vote, Moderator Moulton asked for discussion. Sandra Bloomfield asked as to why the additional \$125,000 was needed. Town Manager Locke gave a brief explanation citing that at the April, 2000 ATM the voters had voted to repair the drawbridge at a cost not to exceed \$250,000. With engineering costs coming in at \$49,000 this left \$201,000 for the bridge work. Six (6) bids had just come with the low bid at \$309,830 and the high at \$600,000. Mr. Locke noted that most of the increase was due to electrical and mechanical costs. Mr. Locke also stated that the main intent is to maintain the character of the bridge and that \$15,000 was factored in for contingencies. Mr. and Mrs. Michael Horn also expressed their concern that the integrity of the bridge be maintained. Stillman Bradish asked that the question be moved. Passed, as read, by a show of hands.

ARTICLE 3: Motion was made and seconded to accept the Article as read. Passed, as read, by a show of hands.

ARTICLE 4: Motion was made and seconded to accept the Article as read. Passed, as read, by a show of hands.

There being no further business before the floor, Moderator Moulton declared the Meeting adjourned at 7:24 PM.
