

Transfer Station

We at the Transfer Station care about the health and well-being of the people of Ogunquit and the customers we serve. During this public health emergency, we need everyone to take this situation seriously. We are asking you to work with us to reduce face-to-face interactions, practice social distancing, and not expose yourselves or others to the highly contagious COVID-19.

To help ensure the Transfer Station can stay open and we can continue to serve you, *the Transfer Station will be closed on Tuesday and Thursday starting June 30, 2020.* We are a small staff and if any one of us becomes sick and can't work, we will not be able to staff the Transfer Station adequately and safely.

Open 5 days a week 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Closed Tuesday and Thursday

Household Waste Disposal

For safety reasons, we are asking for your help:

- Reduce the number of times you come to the Transfer Station. This will help reduce the number of times you have face to face interactions with the Transfer Station employees and with other members of the public.
- When you do come, please observe the recommended social/physical distance of 6 feet. For your safety, we have a measuring sign to help you stay 6 feet away from the next person. We ask that you follow that physical distancing for your and other people's health.
