The Town of Ogunquit is committed to having a safe and welcoming environment. We are seeking people who want to help our community stay healthy, and stop the spread of the Coronavirus. Ambassadors will greet and educate the public on safe practices such as wearing a mask, keeping safe distances, and abiding by other Town rules.

The ideal Community Ambassador is friendly, welcoming, enthusiastic, patient and likes working with the public as you provide information to keep people safe while they enjoy being in Ogunquit.

#### **Job Responsibilities**

- Effectively communicate with the public in a friendly and welcoming manner about the requirement to wear masks and to keep a physical distance
- Create a safe and welcoming environment for the public. Assignment areas include: Ogunquit beaches, the Marginal Way, Perkins Cove, the Town Square, Beach St, Shore Rd., and other areas as needed.
- Assist the Town Health Officer by checking with local shops and restaurants to see if they need assistance with signs, keeping patrons safely distanced, masks, etc.
- Communicate specific COVID-19 safety guidelines and general regulations to the public
- Keep note of comments, questions, or concerns that will help the Town improve
- Other duties as assigned.

#### **Job Requirements**

- Ability to maintain a professional demeanor and attitude
- Ability to stand and walk for an extended period (2+ hours with breaks as needed)
- Ability to work outdoors in various types of weather, especially hot weather

Training will be provided regarding health guidelines, best ways to work with people. As an Ambassador, keeping *you* safe is our first priority. You will be fully equipped with the appropriate face masks, hand sanitizers, and any other supplies you need.
