**Subject:** Commercial deliveries

Maryann -

Sorry for the flurry of emails this morning. I wanted to make the planning board aware of another issue. As stated during the public input on March 9th, there is no space for commercial deliveries at 239 Shore Road. Yesterday, a Miller Beer truck parked in front of our homes blocking traffic and pedestrian use of the side of the road, as well as this driveway. Several other abutters to 239 Shore Road also saw the delivery and photographed this.

During the March 9th meeting, the property owner of 239 Shore Road indicated that deliveries would be very rare - maybe only Fedex trucks who she would instruct to park in the parking spaces next to the trolley stop. As they prepare to get ready for opening a restaurant, we have seen the opposite - regular commercial deliveries throughout the day.

I contacted the code enforcement officer about this. He said I should call the police anytime someone is parked illegally.

If the planning board approves a restaurant at 239 Shore Road, police will be called often by abutters to address regular commercial deliveries parked illegally (again, there is no place for them to park legally). This does not seem like a good use of the town's resources which can be prevented by denying the change of use request.

Is it possible to share this with the planning board?
