The sale from a vehicle of food or drink for consumption or merchandise is prohibited in all public areas of Ogunquit. Ogunquit Municipal Code, Chapter 5, Title IX, Section 504.2 and Section 509.1.

OGUNQUIT MUNICIPAL CODE, CHAPTER 5, TITLE IX, SECTION 510: License Suspension or Revocation...The Board of Selectmen may suspend or revoke any transient business license issued by authority of this Ordinance. Grounds for action shall be misleading or falsification of information on transient business license applications, violation of any municipal ordinance or regulation or that public health, safety and welfare has been adversely affected by action of a licensee.

**License Fee - \$200.00 for each day. Three day maximum that anyone can sell in Ogunquit.**

A person, whether or not licensed shall not conduct transient business between the hours of 8:00 PM and 8:00 AM. This limitation shall not apply to sales or service personnel whom residents may call to their homes at other times. OGUNQUIT MUNICIPAL CODE, CHAPTER 5, TITLE IX, SECTION 509.3

OGUNQUIT MUNICIPAL CODE, CHAPTER 5, TITLE IX, SECTION 512: ENFORCEMENT Ogunquit Police Officers are authorized to enforce the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 513: PENALTIES – The penalty for violations of this ordinance, except where specified, shall be a fine of not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$100.00, or by imprisonment for not more than 30 days, or by both. Each day that a violation occurs or continues shall be considered a separate offense. Fines collected for violations of this Ordinance shall be recovered for the use of the Town of Ogunquit.
