SPECIAL TOWN MEETING OF THE
TOWN OF OGUNQUIT

JANUARY 20, 1981

TO WILLIAM P. HANCOCK, JR., Chief of Police in the Town of Ogunquit, County of York and State of Maine:

GREETINGS:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Town of Ogunquit, qualified by law to vote in town affairs, to meet in the Dunaway Community Center, in said town on Tuesday, the twentieth day of January, 1981, A.D. at seven-thirty o'clock in the evening then and there to act on the following Articles:

ARTICLE 1: To elect a Moderator to preside at said Meeting.

ARTICLE 2: To see if the Town will vote to amend the Ordinance for Shellfish Digging License, as voted at the April 2, 1979 Annual Meeting, as follows:

(Definition changes)

"Municipality: Municipality means the Town of Ogunquit, Maine

Resident: Resident means a person who has resided in the State of Maine for at least six (6) months next prior to the time of his claim of such residence is made, and who has resided in this Municipality for at least three (3) months next prior to the time of his claim of residence is made.

Non-Resident: Non-resident means an ad valorem property tax paying owner of real estate in this Municipality."




