To CECIL F. PERKINS, A Police Officer in the Ogunquit Village Corporation in the Town of Wells, County of York and State of Maine:

GREETINGS:

In the name of the State of Maine you are hereby required to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Ogunquit Village Corporation, qualified by law to vote in Corporation affairs, to meet in Firemen's Hall in said Corporation on Monday, the twenty-fourth day of January 1972, A.D. at seven-thirty o'clock in the evening then and there to act on the following Articles:

ARTICLE 1: To choose a Moderator to preside at said Meeting.

ARTICLE 2: To see if the Corporation will vote to appropriate from money unappropriated at the Annual Meeting the sum of four thousand two hundred thirty six dollars and sixty three cents (\$4,236.63) to cover an overdraft in the Dump Account of that amount.

ARTICLE 3: To see if the Corporation will vote to appropriate from money unappropriated at the Annual Meeting the sum of six hundred thirty four dollars and eighty seven cents (\$634.87) to cover an overdraft in the Insurance Account of that amount.

ARTICLE 4: To see if the Corporation will vote to appropriate from money unappropriated at the Annual Meeting the sum of one thousand three hundred eighty one dollars (\$1,381.00) to cover an overdraft in the Cove Account of that amount.

ARTICLE 5: To see if the Corporation will authorize the Overseers to convey to the Ogunquit Sewer District an easement to lay and maintain a sewer line on Corporation property lying on the southerly side of Cottage Street, so called, and being bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point which marks the southwesterly corner of the intersection of Cottage Street and Shore Road, so-called; thence running by said Shore Road South 10° 57' East eleven and forty-three hundredths (11.43) feet to a point; thence turning and running South 64° 00' 44" West by remaining land of the said grantor, one hundred fifty-eight and ninety-four hundredths (158.94) feet to a point; thence turning and running North 35° 59' 16" West fifteen (15) feet to a point; thence turning and running North 64° 00' 44" East ninety-four and ninety-two hundredths (94.92) feet to a point in the southerly side of said Cottage Street; thence continuing North 67° 23' 41" East by and along said Cottage Street, sixty-seven and ten hundredths (67.10) feet to said Shore Road and the point of beginning. Said area containing an area of 2,280 square feet.

and to execute an easement for such purposes.

ARTICLE 6: To transact such other business that may legally come before this meeting.
