SPECIAL MEETING

OGUNQUIT VILLAGE CORPORATION

To CECIL F. PERKINS, a Police Officer in the Ogunquit Village Corporation in the Town of Wells, County of York and State of Maine:

GREETINGS:

In the name of the State of Maine you are hereby required to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Ogunquit Village Corporation, qualified by law to vote in Corporation affairs, to meet in Firemen's Hall in said Corporation on Thursday, the twenty-eighth day of January, 1971, A.D. at seven-thirty o'clock in the evening then and there to act on the following Articles:

ARTICLE 1: To choose a Moderator to preside at said meeting.

ARTICLE 2: To see if the Corporation will vote to appropriate the sum of \$3,100.00 to cover an overdraft in the Police Account.

ARTICLE 3: To see if the Corporation will vote to appropriate from money received from the sale of Fire Trucks the sum of \$1,000.00 to repay Leonard Wyman the money he loaned to the Ogunquit Fire Company to aid in the purchase of the new Fire Truck.

ARTICLE 4: To hear a report of the Overseers on their efforts in the Wells-Ogunquit Tax Dispute and to consider what further action shall be taken.

ARTICLE 5: To transact such other business as may legally come before this meeting.
