

WARRANT for SPECIAL MEETING
of the
OGUNQUIT VILLAGE CORPORATION

To WILLIAM H. HOLMAN, a Police Officer in the Ogunquit Village Corporation in the Town of Wells, County of York and State of Maine:

GREETINGS:

In the name of the State of Maine you are hereby required to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Ogunquit Village Corporation, qualified by law to vote in Corporation affairs, to meet in Firemen's Hall in said Corporation on Wednesday, the ninth day of May, 1973, A. D. at seven-thirty o'clock in the evening then and there to act on the following Articles:

ARTICLE 1: To choose a Moderator to preside at said meeting.

ARTICLE 2: To see if the Corporation will vote to authorize the Overseers to perambulate and establish boundary lines between property of the Village Corporation and property of Leon Perkins and Wellington Young lying on the southerly side of Agamenticus Road, and if necessary to have said lines surveyed, and further, to authorize said Overseers to execute and accept whatever deed or deeds may be necessary to properly establish said boundary lines.

ARTICLE 3: To see if the Corporation will vote to rescind its action whereby it voted under Article 41 at the 1973 Annual Corporation Meeting with respect to beach parking, as follows:

"that no motel or hotel or rooming houses shall have seasonal passes; residents, taxpayers and renters, seasonal or year 'round, may purchase seasonal passes at \$5.00. Daily rates \$2.50 weekends and \$1.00 daily"

and to continue the fees on the same basis as in 1972. On petition of Kenneth R. Young, Sr. and forty-five others.

ARTICLE 4: To see if the Corporation will vote to amend its action under Article 51 of the Annual Corporation Meeting by substituting in place of "Chamber of Commerce", "Christmas Parade Committee under the direction of Mr. Real G. Mathieu, Chairman" to sponsor the 1973 Christmas Parade. On petition of Barbara A. Putnam and 40 others.

ARTICLE 5: To see if the Corporation will vote to appropriate from Unappropriated Surplus the sum of \$5,500.00 for rent of \$3,500.00 for one year beginning May 15, 1973, and wages for two attendants thru the summer season at the Jacobs Parking Lot.

ARTICLE 6: To see if the Corporation will vote to authorize the Overseers to investigate the cost of construction of Public Toilet Facilities, such as are available at the Ogunquit Beach and Perkins Cove, in the Parking Area adjacent to the Shell Gas Station or some other suitable downtown location and report to a later meeting. On petition of Alf Kristiansen and 26 others.
