

WARRANT FOR A SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
OF THE
TOWN OF OGUNQUIT

TO: WILLIAM P. HANCOCK, JR., Chief of Police in the Town of Ogunquit, County of York and State of Maine.

GREETINGS:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby requested to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Town of Ogunquit, qualified by law to vote in Town affairs, to meet in the Dunaway Community Center, in said Town on Thursday, the twenty-fifth day of June 1992, A.D. at seven o'clock in the evening, prevailing time, there and then to act upon Articles 1 through and including 6.

ARTICLE 1: To elect a Moderator to preside over said Meeting.

ARTICLE 2: Shall the Town vote to appropriate a sum of money not to exceed \$15,000 from the Town's unappropriated fund balance (surplus) for the purpose only of supplementing those funds appropriated within Article 44 at the Annual Town Meeting held on April 6, 1992, the same, or a portion thereof, to be tendered to the Department of the Army Corps of Engineering for the purposes cited in said Article 44 of the aforementioned 1992 Annual Town Meeting?

ARTICLE 3: Shall the Town vote to authorize the Municipal Officers to solicit, borrow, sign notes for and expend a sum of money not to exceed \$24,000 upon such terms and conditions as the Municipal Officers shall believe in the best interests of the Town, for the purpose of replacing the existing electric heating system within the Dunaway Community Center with an oil-fired, hot-water heating system?

ARTICLE 4: Shall the Town vote to appropriate a sum of money not to exceed \$12,000 from the Town's unappropriated fund balance (surplus) for the purpose only of training and inoculating municipal employees against the risk of Bloodborne Pathogens, as mandated by federal and state law?

ARTICLES 5 & 6 ARE BY CITIZENS PETITION


ARTICLE 5: Shall the Town vote to appropriate from surplus a sum not to exceed \$12,000 for a 3.1% cost-of-living increase, effective April 6, 1992, for all full-time, non-union, non-contractual employees?

ARTICLE 6: Shall the Town vote to appropriate from surplus sum not to exceed \$2,700 for the costs of workers' compensation insurance, social security and medicare taxes, and pension and retirement benefits?






