

WARRANT FOR A SPECIAL TOWN MEETING

OF THE

TOWN OF OGUNQUIT

TO: WILLIAM P. HANCOCK, JR., Chief of Police in the Town of Ogunquit, County of York and State of Maine.

GREETINGS:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby requested to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Town of Ogunquit, qualified by law to vote in Town affairs, to meet in the Dunaway Community Center on School Street in said Town on Tuesday, August 16, 1988 A.D. at seven o'clock in the evening, then and there to act on Articles 1 through 7.

ARTICLE 1: To elect a Moderator to preside over said Meeting.

ARTICLE 2: Shall the Town vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Sixteen Thousand, Seventy-Three Dollars (\$16,073) and authorize its use to fully fund the provisions of the first thirty-nine (39) weeks of the new two (2) year contracts with the Public Works Department employees (\$3,479), the Police Department employees (\$6,262), and the Communications Department employees (\$6,332)?

BUDGET COMMITTEE RECOMMENDS: Yes 3/0

ARTICLE 3: Shall the Town vote to raise and appropriate the sum of One Thousand, Three Hundred and Fifty-Five Dollars (\$1,355) for the Employees Benefit Account?

BUDGET COMMITTEE RECOMMENDS: Yes 3/0

ARTICLE 4: Shall the Town vote to transfer the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) from the Sidewalk/Curb Repair Account to the Communications Department Account, Supplies and Expenses line, to be used for the training of personnel in that Department?

ARTICLE 5: Shall the Town vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) and authorize the expenditure of up to that amount for engineering services to provide design and bid specifications for the repairs necessary to stabilize /restore the area under the Perkins Cove Baitwharf and slab?


ARTICLE 6: Shall the Town vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) and authorize the expenditure of up to that amount for engineering services to provide design and bid specifications for repairs necessary to stabilize /restore the area under the Perkins Cove Baitwharf and slab; to provide design and bid specifications and cost estimates for repairing/ replacing the existing bulkheads at Perkins Cove and for the dredging of Perkins Cove?

BUDGET COMMITTEE RECOMMENDS: Yes 3/0

ARTICLE 7: Voted: (1) That a capital improvement project consisting of the engineering design of a new bulkhead and preparation of cost estimates for bulkhead and dredging at Perkins Cove is hereby appropriated; and (2) to fund said capital improvement project a sum not to exceed Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) is hereby approved; and (3) to meet said appropriation, the Treasurer and Chairman of the Board of Selectmen, acting pursuant to the provisions of 30 MRSA 5152, are hereby authorized to issue general obligation securities of the Town of Ogunquit (including temporary notes in anticipation of the sale thereof) in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) and the discretion to fix the date(s), maturity(ies), interest rate(s), denomination(s), place(s) of payment, form and other details of said securities, including execution and delivery of said securities on behalf of the Town of Ogunquit, and to provide for the sale thereof, is


ARTICLE 7: hereby delegated to the Treasurer and Chairman of the Board of Selectmen.






