

WARRANT FOR A SPECIAL TOWN MEETING  
OF THE  
TOWN OF OGUNQUIT

TO: MICHAEL W. PARDUE, Chief of Police in the Town of Ogunquit,  
County of York and State of Maine.

GREETINGS:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby requested to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Town of Ogunquit, qualified by law to vote in Town affairs, to meet in the Dunaway Community Center, in said Town on Wednesday, the thirteenth day of September, 1995, A.D., at 7 o'clock in the evening to vote on Articles 1 through 11.

ARTICLE 1: To elect a Moderator to preside over said Meeting.

ARTICLE 2: Shall the Town vote to appropriate the sum of Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00) from taxation for **Odyssey of the Mind**?

ARTICLE 3: Shall the Town vote to appropriate the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) from taxation for **Watts for Warriors**?

ARTICLE 4: Shall the Town vote to accept and expend the bequest of Lewis Worster, as cited in Mr. Worster's Revocable Inter-Vivos Trust of May 20, 1981; the bequest being made to the Town of Ogunquit in the amount of Seven Thousand Dollars (\$7,000.00) for use at its **DUNAWAY CENTER**?

ARTICLE 5: Shall the Town vote to appropriate the sum of Forty-Nine Thousand, Nine Hundred and Seventy-Seven Dollars and Fifty-Four Cents (\$49,977.54) from taxation for the increase in tipping fees from **Regional Waste Systems (RWS)** for the period of July 1, 1995 to December 31, 1995?

ARTICLE 6: Shall the Town vote to appropriate the sum of Fifteen Thousand, Four Hundred and Forty Dollars and Twenty-Five Cents (\$15,440.25) from surplus for the purpose of seal coating and striping of the Main Beach Parking Lot?

ARTICLE 7: Shall the Town vote for the Board of Selectmen to continue to oppose the acceptance of sewage from the Cliff House in York to the Ogunquit Sewage Treatment Plant?

ARTICLE 8: Shall the Town vote to appropriate the sum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) from taxation for **Legal Fees**?

ARTICLE 9: Shall the Town vote to authorize the Municipal Officers to accept, on behalf of the Town, donations for the purpose of financing improvements to the **Perkins Cove Sign** and to authorize the Municipal Officers to expend such funds, including principal and interest, only for the purposes intended by the donor(s) or benefactor(s)?


ARTICLE 10: Shall the Town vote to adopt the following amendment to Title IV, Chapter 5, Section 502 of the Ogunquit Municipal Code?

\*No person shall operate or permit the operation of any wheeled vehicle, including bicycles, **skateboards/in-line skates** on the Marginal Way. This Article shall not be construed so as to include wheelchairs, strolled or like vehicles.

ARTICLE 11: Shall the Town of Ogunquit, through its Municipal Officers, have the authority to perform the functions of a Transit District, without having to formally create a District, as authorized by 30-A M.R.S.A. 3505?






