

WARRANT
FOR
SPECIAL TOWN MEETING

To WILLIAM P. HANCOCK, JR., CHIEF OF POLICE OF THE TOWN OF OGUNQUIT, COUNTY OF YORK AND STATE OF MAINE.

GREETINGS:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Town of Ogunquit, qualified by law to vote in Town affairs, to meet in the S. Judson-Dunaway Community Center, School Street, Ogunquit, Maine, on the fourth (4th) day of October, 1982 A.D. at seven thirty (7:30) o'clock in the evening then and there to act on the following Articles:

- ARTICLE 1: To choose a Moderator to preside at said meeting.
- ARTICLE 2: To see if the Town will vote to discontinue a certain lot or parcel of land, together with the building thereon situated on the easterly side of the Post Road also known as U.S. Route #1, in Ogunquit, County of York, State of Maine, with reference to a "sketch showing land surveyed for Joseph Littlefield dated February 16, 1982" by Dow & Coulombe, Inc., and a Maine D.O.T. Right of Way map entitle "State Highway 1", Wells (Ogunquit) State Project No. 1-1 (502)" dated January 1956, File No. 16-110, as petitioned by Joseph Littlefield in accordance with Title 23 M.R.S.A. Section 3026.

BUDGET COMMITTEE RECOMMENDS: YES 5-0 IN FAVOR

- ARTICLE 3: To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to expend an amount not to exceed Two Thousand Dollars (2,000.) from the Legal Fees account for the cost of Maine Municipal Association services in the selection process of a Town Manager.

BUDGET COMMITTEE RECOMMENDS: YES 5-0 IN FAVOR

- ARTICLE 4: To see if the Town will vote to appropriate a sum not to exceed Nine Hundred Dollars (\$900.) from surplus Alarm fee receipts for the costs of updating the teletype system in accordance with the State of Maine Law Enforcement network.

NOTE- The sum of \$3,000 was anticipated for 1982 receipts and \$4,000 has been received.

BUDGET COMMITTEE RECOMMENDS: YES 5-0 IN FAVOR

- ARTICLE 5: To see if the Town will vote to appropriate the sum of Ten Thousand Six Hundred Dollars (\$10,600) from unappropriated General Fund Surplus to the Employee Benefit-Group Insurance account to cover premiums generated by a general rate increase for the balance of the fiscal year.

BUDGET COMMITTEE RECOMMENDS: YES 5-0 IN FAVOR

- ARTICLE 6: To see if the Town will vote to appropriate from unappropriated General Fund surplus the amount of Three Thousand Six Hundred and Seventy-one Dollars (\$3,671) for allocation to the following line item accounts:

Administration-Manager's Salary	\$2,971.
Code Enforcement-Supply Account	700.
	<hr/> \$3,671.

NOTE - The former Manager was paid \$4,328. in unused benefits pay;

due to "interim" Manager services, a balance of \$1,357. will result in the salary account-which is the basis of the \$2,971. request.

BUDGET COMMITTEE RECOMMENDS: YES 5-0 IN FAVOR

ARTICLE 7: To see if the Town will vote to appropriate a sum not to exceed Five Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$5,500.) from surplus Lower Parking Lot receipts to be added to the line item accounts in the Highway Department, as follows:

1. Equipment Repair	Backhoe	\$1,000.
	International	\$1,000.
	4 X 4	300.
	Loader	200.
2. Maintenance Supplies		\$3,000.

NOTE - The sum of \$15,000. was anticipated in receipts and \$24,219. has been received.

BUDGET COMMITTEE RECOMMENDS: YES 5-0 IN FAVOR

ARTICLE 8: To see if the Town will vote to appropriate a sum not to exceed Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.) from surplus Lower Parking Lot receipts to be added to the line item account in the Highway Department, as follows:

Snow Removal-10 ft. Swivel Plow	\$3,000.
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NOTE-See Note following Article 7.

BUDGET COMMITTEE RECOMMENDS: YES 5-0 IN FAVOR

ARTICLE 9: To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to expend an amount not to exceed One Thousand Four Hundred Fifty (\$1,450.) anticipated Surplus from the Lifeguard and Perkins Retirement accounts to the following line item accounts:


