

WARRANT FOR A SPECIAL TOWN MEETING

OF THE

TOWN OF OGUNQUIT

TO: MICHAEL W. PARDUE, Chief of Police in the Town of Ogunquit, County of York and State of Maine.

GREETINGS:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby requested to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Town of Ogunquit, qualified by law to vote in Town affairs, to meet in the Dunaway Community Center, in said Town on Tuesday, the second day of November, 1993, A.D. at ten o'clock in the morning until eight o'clock in the evening of the same day, then and there to vote by secret ballot on Articles 1 through 3.

ARTICLE 1: To elect a Moderator to preside over said Meeting.

ARTICLE 2: Shall the Municipality approve the Charter revisions recommended by the Charter Commission in the form posted and previously made available in the Town Clerk's Office for inspection, use and examination by the public?

ARTICLE 3: Shall the Plan entitled "1992 Comprehensive Plan" be amended in the form posted and previously made available in the Town Clerk's Office for inspection, use, and examination by the public which includes revisions and amendments made through 1993?


The Board of Selectmen hereby gives Notice that the polls shall be open for voting purposes at ten o'clock in the morning or as soon as possible thereafter, on the date of the said Special Town Meeting and that the polls will not be closed earlier than eight o'clock in the evening of the same day.

The Registrar of Voters will hold office hours while the polls are open to correct any changes or errors in name or address on the voting list, to accept the registration of any person eligible to vote and to accept enrollments.

A person who is not enrolled as a voter may not vote in an election. A voter who is not enrolled in a political party may not vote in a primary election.




