

WARRANT FOR A SPECIAL TOWN MEETING

OF THE

TOWN OF OGUNQUIT

TO: WILLIAM P. HANCOCK, JR., Chief of Police in the Town of Ogunquit, County of York and State of Maine.

GREETINGS:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby requested to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Town of Ogunquit, qualified by law to vote in Town affairs, to meet in the Dunaway Community Center, in said Town on Tuesday, the third day of November 1992, A.D. at ten o'clock in the morning until eight o'clock in the evening to vote by secret ballot on Articles 1 and 2.

ARTICLE 1: To elect a Moderator to preside over said Meeting.

ARTICLE 2: To elect the following Officer for the term so noted or until such time as a successor is elected and qualified:

- A. One (1) Selectman: For a term to commence upon election and being sworn in; term ending as of Annual Town Meeting, 1993.

The Board of Selectmen hereby gives Notice that the polls shall be open for voting purposes at ten o'clock in the morning or as soon as possible thereafter on the date of said Meeting and that polls shall not be closed earlier than eight o'clock in the evening of the same day.

The Registrar of Voters will hold office hours while the polls are open to correct any error in or change a name or address on the voting list, to accept the registration of any person eligible to vote and to accept new enrollments.

A person who is not registered as a voter may not vote in any election. A voter who is not enrolled in a political party may not vote in a primary election.

Construction Easement between Leon C. Perkins and Lillian M. Perkins, 120 Shore Road, Ogunquit, ME, and the Town of Ogunquit, ME. Beginning October 26, 1992 and ending May 1, 1993.

Permission is hereby granted to said Town to enter upon area known as Perkins Parking Lot to stockpile material, replace existing drain pipe, install new catch basin with drain top, (not solid), connect cellar drain from 120 Shore Rd. to new catch basin higher than primary drain pipe.

Said Town shall be responsible for all State (D.E.P.) or any other permits necessary. Any erosion that may occur at outfall site during construction or in future shall be Town responsibility. Any sod that is removed during construction shall be replaced with sod not seeded.

If the catch basin in edge of Shore Road has to be replaced sodded dike shall be maintained. Any fence posts or rails that are removed or broken shall be replaced. Any breaks or cracks in entrance apron (hot top) shall be fixed. Any area in parking lot that has been disturbed shall be graded with crushed gravel to our approval.
