

WARRANT FOR SPECIAL TOWN MEETING

of the

TOWN OF OGUNQUIT

To BRIAN N. WESTMAN, Acting Chief of Police in the Town of Ogunquit, County of York and State of Maine:

GREETINGS:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby requested to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Town of Ogunquit, qualified by law to vote in Town affairs, to meet in the Dunaway Community Center in said Town on Tuesday, the fourth day of November, 1986 A.D. at nine o'clock in the morning until eight o'clock in the evening, then and there to vote by secret ballot on Article 1 through 3:

ARTICLE 1: To elect a Moderator to preside at said meeting.

ARTICLE 2: To elect the following officer for the term so noted.

A. One (1) Selectman - Term will run from November 4, 1986, to April 7, 1987 (Annual Town Meeting).

ARTICLE 3: Shall the Town vote, by Referendum, to allow manufactured housing, including mobile homes in Ogunquit? All such housing must meet the requirements of the Ogunquit Zoning Ordinance, Subdivision Standards, Building Code and the Fire Safety Code. All structures must contain a minimum of 650 square feet, and mobile homes must be 40 feet long and placed on a permanent foundation approved by the Code Enforcement Officer. A mobile home must meet local, state and Federal design standards. A mobile home must be placed with the 40 foot length parallel to the street upon which it is located.

READ THE FOLLOWING BEFORE VOTING

EXPLANATION: This change in the Zoning Ordinance has been legislated by State Statute. Failure of the voters to approve this change allows the State to locate mobile homes anywhere in Ogunquit regardless of Town Ordinances. At this time, manufactured housing, (components produced at a plant away from the site) are located in most Ogunquit districts. Examples are the Aspinquid, Lemon Tree, Deck House and Stan Mar homes in the Residential Districts. While these are not mobile homes, the Statute includes mobile homes as manufacturing housing.

The Board of Selectmen hereby gives notice that the meeting will be held at nine o'clock in the morning of said day. Given under our hands this twenty-first day of October, 1986 A.D.
