

WARRANT FOR A SPECIAL TOWN MEETING

OF THE

TOWN OF OGUNQUIT

TO: WILLIAM P. HANCOCK, JR., Chief of Police in the Town of Ogunquit, County of York and State of Maine.

GREETINGS:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby requested to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Town of Ogunquit, qualified by law to vote in Town affairs, to meet in the Dunaway Community Center on School Street in said Town on Wednesday, November 20, 1991 A.D. at seven o'clock in the evening, then and there to act on Articles 1 through 11.

ARTICLE 1: To elect a Moderator to preside over said Meeting.

ARTICLE 2: Shall the Town vote to transfer \$1,000 from surplus funds to the Street Light Account?

ARTICLE 3: Shall the Town vote to transfer \$6,000 from surplus funds to the Group Health Insurance Account?

BUDGET COMMITTEE RECOMMENDS: 4/0 Yes

ARTICLE 4: Shall the Town vote to transfer \$2,000 from surplus funds to the General Assistance Account?

BUDGET COMMITTEE RECOMMENDS: 4/0 Yes

ARTICLE 5: Shall the Town vote to transfer \$3,000 from surplus funds to the Unemployment Fund Account?

ARTICLE 6: Shall the Town vote to transfer \$8,000 from surplus funds to the Police Department Account?

ARTICLE 7: Shall the Town vote to transfer \$1,000 from surplus funds to the Beach Maintenance Account?

ARTICLE 8: Shall the Town vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to take any and all actions necessary and incidental to provide for the repair and restoration of public property damaged by the recent storm?

ARTICLE 9: Shall the Town vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to sign a permanent right-of-way easement deed to the Ogunquit Sewer District for the purpose of incorporating a portion of the existing access driveway having dimensions totaling 3,831.58 square feet?

ARTICLE 10: Shall the Town vote to accept an easement deed from Alex Shoag of Bayview Avenue for the purpose of installing, maintaining, repairing and replacing a drainage pipe on grantor's property at the end of Bayview Avenue?

ARTICLE 11: Shall the Town vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to expend up to 4/12ths of the 1991 Budget during the period from January 1, 1992 until the Annual Town Meeting?


