To CECIL F. PERKINS, a Police Officer in the Ogunquit Village Corporation in the Town of Wells, County of York and State of Maine:

GREETINGS:

In the name of the State of Maine you are hereby required to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Ogunquit Village Corporation, qualified by law to vote in Corporation affairs, to meet in Firemen's Hall in said Corporation on Tuesday, the nineteenth day of December 1972 A.D. at seven-thirty o'clock in the evening then and there to act on the following Articles:

ARTICLE 1: To choose a Moderator to preside at said Meeting.

ARTICLE 2: To see if the Corporation will vote to appropriate from the Unappropriated Surplus Account the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) for the purpose of paying the heirs of Robert Laurent in full settlement of the claim which Robert Laurent brought against the Ogunquit Village Corporation in August, 1967, for the alledged unlawful acquisition and use of his land at Perkins Cove in said Ogunquit. In consideration for said settlement the heirs of Robert Laurent will convey by quit-claim deed to the Ogunquit Village Corporation all that property which is bounded on the North by land of William R. Tower, Jr. and Bernice C. Tower; on the East by the Atlantic Ocean; on the South by studio property of the heirs of Robert Laurent, and on the West by the Josias River or Perkins Cove, so called. This shall include that area of land which contains the bait wharf lying on the easterly side of the Cove.

ARTICLE 3: To see if the Corporation will vote to appropriate from the Unappropriated Surplus Account the sum of Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00) for the purpose of repairing, with Granite, the Bulkhead at Perkins Cove,

ARTICLE 4: To transact such other business that may legally come before this meeting.
