

WARRANT FOR A SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
OF THE
TOWN OF OGUNQUIT

TO: MICHAEL W. PARDUE, Chief of Police in the Town of
Ogunquit, County of York and State of Maine.

GREETINGS:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby requested to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Town of Ogunquit, qualified by law to vote in Town affairs, to meet in the Dunaway Community Center, in said Town on Tuesday, the twenty-first day of December, 1993, A.D. at seven o'clock in the evening, then and there to vote on Articles 1 through 9.

ARTICLE 1: To elect a Moderator to preside over said Meeting.

ARTICLE 2: Shall the Town vote to appropriate the additional sum of Eight Thousand Dollars (\$8,000) from unanticipated revenues (surplus funds) to the Public Safety (Police Department) account?

ARTICLE 3: Shall the Town vote to appropriate the additional sum of Three Thousand, Five Hundred Dollars (\$3,500) from unanticipated revenues (surplus funds) to the Public Works (Harbormaster) account?

ARTICLE 4: Shall the Town vote to appropriate the additional sum of Three Thousand, One Hundred Dollars (\$3,100) from unanticipated revenues (surplus funds) to the Public Works (Beach Maintenance) account?

ARTICLE 5: Shall the Town vote to appropriate the additional sum of Three Thousand, Five Hundred Dollars (\$3,500) from unanticipated revenues (surplus funds) to the Culture and Recreation (Dunaway Community Center) account?

ARTICLE 6: Shall the Town vote to appropriate the additional sum of Two Hundred and Eight Dollars (\$208) from unanticipated revenues (surplus funds) to Public Safety (Fire Hydrants)?

ARTICLE 7: Shall the Town vote to appropriate the additional sum of Nineteen Thousand, Eight Hundred and Six Dollars (\$19,806) from unanticipated revenues (surplus funds) to Unclassified Municipal Accounts (Legal Expenses)?

ARTICLE 8: Shall the Town vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to enter into a sales agreement for the upgrade of the Police Department computer system? (All funds, other than the deposit, to be appropriated at the 1994 Annual Town Meeting (Funding not to exceed \$25,000.)


ARTICLE 9: Shall the Town vote to accept monies from the York County Forfeiture (CV-90-929) in the sum of Nine Thousand Four Hundred Fifty Dollars and any accrued interest to be used for the purpose of drug interdiction?


