WARRANT RETURN FOR THE ANNUAL TOWN MEETING
OF THE
TOWN OF OGUNQUIT

April 2 & 4, 1994

The Annual Town Meeting was called to order by Town Clerk Judy Shaw-Kagiliery with the Reading of the Call, Return and First Article. The Meeting convened at 9:00 A.M.

Linda Ireland, Mary Littlefield, Violet Rand and Norma Turnbull served as Ballot Clerks/Counters. Articles 1-5 were done by secret ballot. A total of 117 people voted at the April 4 Town Meeting. Polls closed at 6:00 P.M.

ARTICLE 1: Robert Ireland was elected Moderator and sworn in by Town Clerk Judy Shaw-Kagiliery.

ARTICLE 3: Article passed 87 YES votes and 24 NO votes.

ARTICLE 4: Article passed with 77 YES votes and 31 NO votes.

ARTICLE 5: Article passed with 79 YES votes and 29 NO votes.

Continuation of the April 4, 1994 Annual Town Meeting proceeded at 7:20 P.M. on Monday, April 6, 1994. Moderator Robert Ireland appointed Wayne Adams as Deputy Moderator and he was sworn in by Town Clerk Judy Shaw-Kagiliery. A total of 101 citizens attended the evening Meeting. Mr. Adams called the Meeting to order and called for a Motion to extend the courtesy to non-residents to speak during the Meeting. The Motion was made and seconded to do so. Motion passed, as presented, by a show of hands.

ARTICLE 6: Motion was made to to move the Article out of order and take up after Article 20 to ensure a quorum to pass the vote. Seconded. Passed with a show of hands.

Motion was then made to accept an amendment to increase the amount to be appropriated from \$55,820 to \$151,019. Seconded. Motion failed by a show of hands.


