

## OF THE TOWN OF OGUNQUIT

April 3 &amp; 5, 1993

The Annual Town Meeting was called to order by Deputy Town Clerk Judy Shaw-Kagiliery with the Reading of the Call, Return and First Article. The Meeting convened at 9:00 A.M.

Helen Butler, Mary Littlefield, Violet Rand and Norma Turnbull served as Ballot Clerks/Counters. Articles 1-5 were done by secret ballot. A total of 110 people voted at the April 3 Town Meeting. Polls closed at 6:00 P.M.

ARTICLE 1: Robert Ireland was elected Moderator and sworn in by Deputy Town Clerk Judy Shaw-Kagiliery.

ARTICLE 3: Article received 69 YES votes and 29 NO votes. The Article did not pass, however, because a quorum was not met (30% of the number of voters at the last gubernatorial election (196) would have to have voted) Article defeated.
