

WARRANT RETURN FOR THE SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
OF THE
TOWN OF OGUNQUIT

MAY 25, 1999

The Special Town Meeting was called to order by Town Clerk Judy Shaw-Kagiliery with the Reading of the Call, Return and First Article. The Meeting convened at 7:05 P.M.

Ann Clark and Marjorie Esau served as Ballot Clerks. Article 1 was done by written ballot. A total of 56 people attended the Meeting.

ARTICLE 1: Wayne Adams was elected Moderator and sworn in by Town Clerk Judy Shaw-Kagiliery.

ARTICLE 2: Motion was made and seconded to accept the Article, as read. No discussion. Passed, as read, by a show of hands.

ARTICLE 3: Motion was made and seconded to accept the Article, as read. Prior to the call for a vote, Chairman Clark asked that John Cavaretta come forward to address the floor relative the request.

Moderator Adams called for a 2/3 vote from the floor to allow a non-resident to address those in attendance. Motion made and seconded. Passed by a show of hands.

Businessman John Cavaretta spoke as a member of the Parking and Traffic Management Committee and explained that one of the steps toward improved parking and traffic conditions in Ogunquit was the request for the purchase and installation of directional and trolley signs throughout the Town. It is planned to provide thirteen (13) signs for 1999. Mr. Cavaretta also explained that as part of the Maine DOT Six-Year Plan and Phase II of the project, bike paths are proposed from town line to town line and improved sidewalks from the Baptist Church to the center of town.

Following brief discussion, Moderator Adams called for a vote. Motion passed, as read, by a show of hands.


ARTICLE 4: Motion was made to accept the Article as read. Motion seconded. Discussion ensued. George Wilson asked what side of Shore Road would be impacted by the project and the frequency of lights. Town Manager Locke advised the installation will be done on the left side of the street at 100' increments into the Cove. There were several inquiries as to whether or not the main street and historic district of the Town will also be done. Mr. Cavaretta stated that as part of Phase II, sidewalk work and possibly street lights will be done from the Baptist Church to the center of Town. It is also proposed that new sidewalks be built from town line to town line. The reason for the request for lamp posts lights, at this time, is to coordinate the work with the sidewalk project.

Moderator Adams then called for a vote. Passed, as read, by a show of hands.

ARTICLE 5: Motion was made to accept the Article as read. Motion seconded. Brief discussion ensued. Town Manager Locke explained the request was being made in order to bring the non-union employees in-line, salary wise, with surrounding area employees doing the same job. Mr. Locke explained further he had determined the need for the salary adjustments based on an employees' salaries survey he had recently completed. Following a brief discussion, Moderator Adams called for a vote. Passed, as read, by a show of hands.

Determining there was no other business to come before the floor, Moderator Adams declared the Meeting adjourned at 7:30 P.M.
