At a Special Election held on October 1, 1979 as required by Chapter 45 of the Private and Special Laws of 1979, the voters of the Ogunquit Village Corporation replied to the specified referendum question:

"Shall the Ogunquit Village Corporation be separated from the Town of Wells as an incorporated town and shall the Town of Ogunquit join a community school district with the Town of Wells for grades kindergarten to 12 to be known as "Wells-Ogunquit Community School District" to share 100% of the costs based upon each town's state valuation?"

Votes in favor - 480

Votes against - 94

The election was advertised, called, and conducted in compliance with Title 30, Sections 2061 and 2065.
