

WARRANT RETURN FOR THE SPECIAL TOWN MEETING

OF THE

TOWN OF OGUNQUIT

The Polls for the Referendum Election were declared open by Town Clerk Judy Shaw-Kagiliery at ten o'clock in the morning, November 2, 1993.

Linda Ireland, Mary Littlefield, Violet Rand and Janice Ryan served as Ballot Clerks/Counters. Robert Ireland and Judith Yates also served as Counters.

Articles 1 through 3 were done by secret ballot. A total of 321 citizens cast their ballots on the Referendum Questions; nineteen (19) of which were absentee.

The Clerk read the Call, Return and asked for nominations for the election of Moderator (Article 1) -

ARTICLE 1: Helen J. Butler was elected Moderator to preside over the Meeting and was sworn in by Town Clerk Judy Shaw-Kagiliery. Ms. Butler declared the Polls for the State Referendum open.

ARTICLE 3: Comprehensive Plan Update - Yes - 237 No - 55

The polls were declared closed at 8:00 P.M. The counting process commenced and was completed at 9:30 P.M. The Meeting was declared adjourned at 9:30 P.M.
