

**WARRANT RETURN
SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
OF THE
TOWN OF OGUNQUIT
December 30, 2002**

The Special Town Meeting was called to order by Town Clerk Judy Shaw-Kagiliery with the Reading of the Call, Return and First Article. The Meeting convened at 7:08 PM. Mary Littlefield served as Ballot Clerk. Article 1 was done by written ballot. A total of 49 registered voters attended the Special Town Meeting.

ARTICLE 1: Wayne Adams was elected as Moderator and sworn in by Town Clerk Judy Shaw-Kagiliery. Prior to the reading of the Articles, a Motion was made and seconded to allow non-residents to address the proceedings, if so requested. Passed, by a show of hands.

ARTICLE 2: Motion was made and seconded to accept the Article as read. Prior to the vote, Moderator Adams called for discussion. Town Manager Dunn addressed the floor and advised the transfer was necessary due to over-expenditures in the Workers' Compensation Account. The figures for the budget are based on payroll estimates and can change based on actual payroll spent and claims submitted for the year. The Budget Committee supported the transfer 4-0. Moderator Adams ended discussion and called for a vote. Article passed, by a show of hands.

ARTICLE 3: Motion was made and seconded to accept the Article as read. Prior to the vote, Moderator Adams called for discussion. Police Chief Rubino addressed the floor and explained the reason for the transfer request. Chief Rubino gave a brief synopsis of what he had had to deal with since coming into the Department (i.e., salary disputes, lack of staffing, lack of supervision and training, unpaid parking tickets, changes in the ordinance relative to the sale of beach passes necessitating additional training and increased personnel coverage to cover longer lines).

Budget Committee Chairman Herbert Hoffman then addressed the floor and stated the Committee had voted unanimously to oppose the article. Questions from the audience were responded to by Chief Rubino and Selectman Bradish then moved to have the debate cut off on the question, seconded by Selectman Maxwell. Passed, by a show of hands.

Motion was made and seconded to accept this Article, as read. Article passed, as read, by a show of hands.

ARTICLE 4: Motion was made and seconded to accept the Article as read. Prior to the vote, Moderator Adams called for discussion. Town Manager Dunn informed those present that by switching from Boston Mutual Insurance to a new insurance carrier (Maine Municipal Association), the Town would save \$17,000 for the Town employees' short-term disability and life insurance. Following brief discussion, Moderator Adams called for a vote and the Article passed, as read, by a show of hands.

There being no further business before the floor, Moderator Adams declared the Meeting adjourned at 7:45 PM.
