Welcome & Introductions

Chair Charley LaFlamme called the meeting to order a 10:05 a.m.

Bicycle Share/Bicycle Rentals Kiosk

Planning Board Public Hearing Monday, 2/26/18, 6:00 p.m. at Dunaway Center – Jennifer and possibly Bob to attend.

- Jennifer has made initial inquiries to LimeBike and Zagster bicycle sharing services.
- Jennifer has initiated a citizen petition that will require 80 signatures to place on the warrant an amendment to the Outside Sales ordinance to add the words “and bicycle share kiosk” to the list of exceptions in the ordinance.

Bicycle Friendly Community re-application through the League of American Bicyclists

- Bruce reported that the application deadline is August 9, 2018 for a November announcement.
- Bruce is looking for a contact in the school district that could provide detail on any bicycle safety curriculum at each level.
- Bruce has a list of questions for the Police Chief.

New Ogunquit Public Works Department Head being hired

- Charley spoke to the Town Manager to see if the Committee could have representation in the selection process. Pat was positive about the Committee having representation.
- Bob volunteered to be on the selection committee.
- Charley referenced Dean Lessard head of Public Works in York as an example of where this has worked well.

BP signs inventory

Bob provided a listing of the sign aberrations.

New England Bicycling & Walking Summits, April 26 & 27, 2018

- Presentation about Ogunquit and the changes the committee has made was selected.

- Charley to attend and present.
- MOTION by John and seconded by Jennifer: To approve sending Charley LaFlamme to the New England Bicycling and Walking Summit in Boston on April 26 and 27, 2018 and to request funding for his expenses. Motion passed unanimously (5-0).

Ogunquit's new Complete Streets Policy

- Bruce added language in current draft to allow groups to work outside of formal meetings and decision making to be primarily on a consensus basis.

- Bruce to complete application and submit.

Ogunquit to Mt A and off/on road paths/Bike Friendly Maps

- Tabled to next meeting.

- Can we have a volunteer day or two during the season to work with CSO's.
- Tabled to next meeting for discussion with the Police Chief.
