

Ogunquit Conservation Commission Meeting Minutes

October 15, 2015

Present: Bill Baker, Doug Mayer, Bill Lee, Glenn Deletetsky, Kristin Rinaldi and Olive (non-voting members).

Absent: Pam Sawyer - Excused.

We discussed the need for new members and reviewed those already asked. Several names were mentioned for follow up.

Bill Baker expressed the need for more visibility for our website, www.ogunquitcoservation.org. Currently, it is under 'Committees' on the town web page. Kristin Rinaldi pointed out that it was the first site to appear Googling 'Ogunquit Conservation.' Members thought this might be all right for the present.

We discussed different places where our many "Green Bags" might be placed – at those businesses listed on the bag and/or for a donation at the Chamber. Follow up is needed.

Those of us who attended the two Canine Workshops described the process used and the possible compromise that had been suggested by both Doug and Bill Lee at an earlier meeting – to allow dogs on leash for the month of September following Labor Day. This would give dog walkers about seven months to walk their dogs on our beach. This was the compromise also suggested at the second Canine Workshop.

Bill Baker described some of the highlights of the FB Steering Committee meeting held October 1, especially Tom suggesting names for the Levitt Stream socials and Tom's working with the RT 1 reconstruction company to pave the lower parking lot in trade for allowing them to stage their equipment there. This will be a saving of \$80,000 that will still be applied toward the town's in kind matching for the 319 Grant.
